The club flying field is located at the *MT. PLEASANT MINIATURE AIRFIELD*, north off of highway 20 and west of highway "H" in the Village of Mt. Pleasant. Turn north onto the road at the intersection of highway 20 and the West Road (at the old red brick school house) and proceed north about ½ mile. If you follow the sign to the Mt. Pleasant compost site, you will find our field.

If you are interested in R/C model airplane flying, please feel free to come to our flying field, and watch the activities, and talk with the members. They will give you some good advice as to what is needed to get into this hobby, and more about our club.

If you are interested in joining the Racine R/C Club, you can fill out the attached application and mail it in to the indicated address. **NOTE: As a flying member, you will also need to be a member of the AMA (Academy of Model Aeronautics) as a condition of membership of our club.** This will provide you with not only a good magazine, but also the necessary insurance we need. **An additional requirement for membership is the manning of the Mt. Pleasant compost site on a Wednesday afternoon, for three, two hour shifts (6 hours) during the year. The Compost Site is open from Noon to 6 PM, roughly from April 1st to November 15th. These are both club rules.**

\*After August 1<sup>st</sup> of each year, dues are 50% of the shown schedule for new members.

**Note:** Membership in the club is conditional upon agreement to assist with staffing the Mt. Pleasant Compost Site for a total of 6 hours per year, on scheduled Wednesday afternoons, Noon - 6 PM, and AMA membership. NOTE: Non-Flying members are not required to be AMA members, but recommended.

That in the event there are insufficient regular and senior citizen members to staff the compost site, that additional staffing to fill vacant positions would be accomplished by:

1. Volunteers from the membership. Volunteers, who do an additional 4 hours, will be excluded from any lottery selection as described in # 2 below. In the event there are insufficient volunteers,
2. A lottery would be used to select members for the additional staffing needs. Those selected to staff the compost site from the lottery would be excluded from any future lottery selections for the next five (5) years, however, they would still be obligated to fulfill their normal, annual, compost site obligations.
